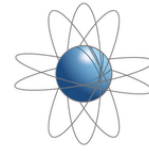

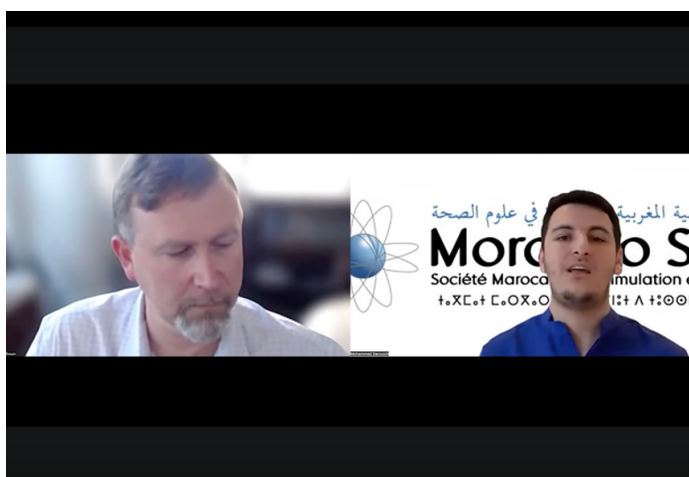

This SHINE Webinar focused on an essential aspect of simulation-based education: preparing and publishing simulation-related research. Led by Aaron Calhoun (SSH, USA) and chaired by Mohammed Derouich, the session provided practical insights into transforming simulation activities into scholarly work and navigating the publication process. Discussions highlighted key principles of research design, manuscript preparation, and dissemination strategies, emphasizing the importance of producing high-quality evidence to advance simulation practice and contribute to the growth of the healthcare simulation community. Participants also explored common challenges, opportunities for collaboration, and strategies to enhance the visibility and impact of simulation scholarship.
